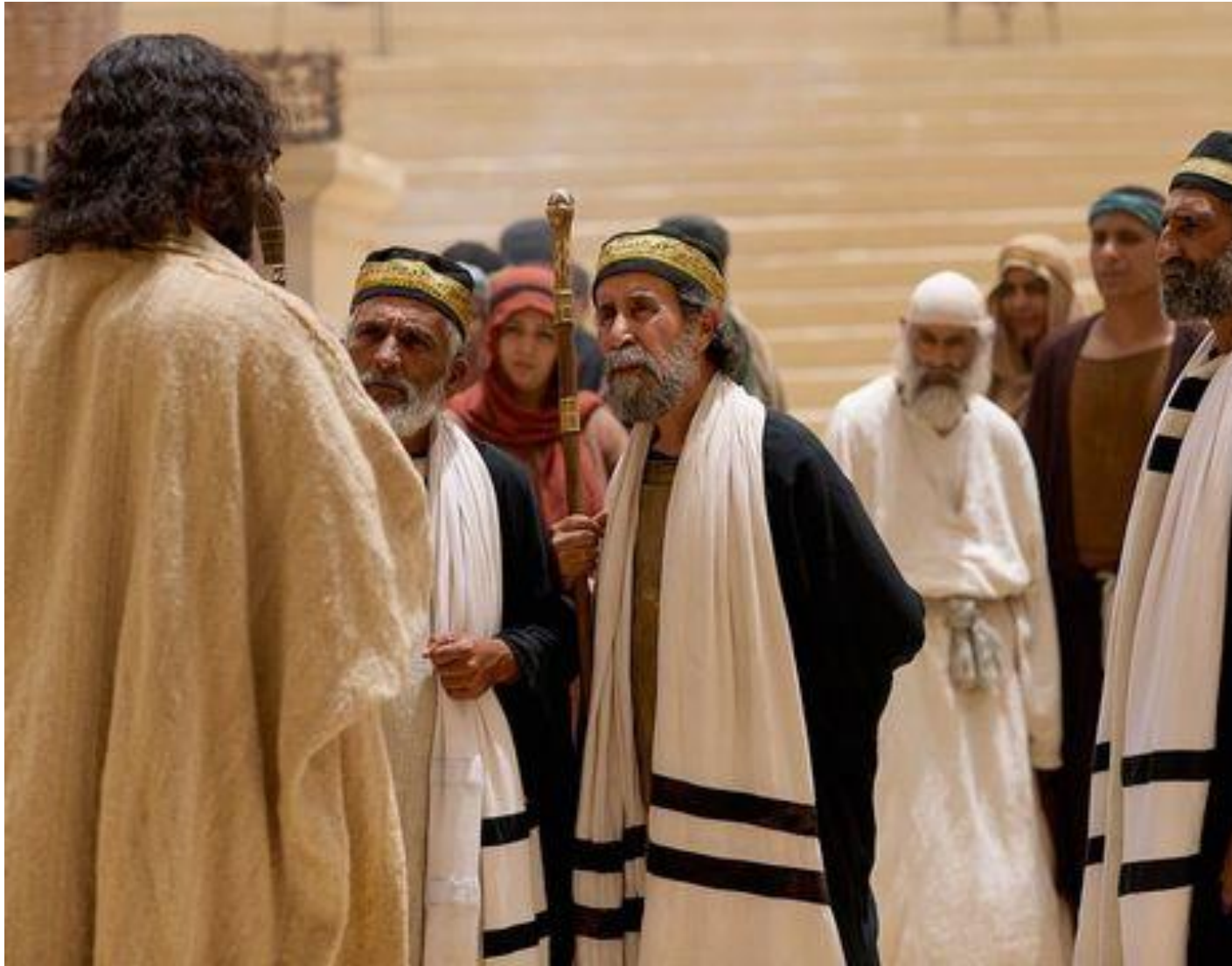

authority



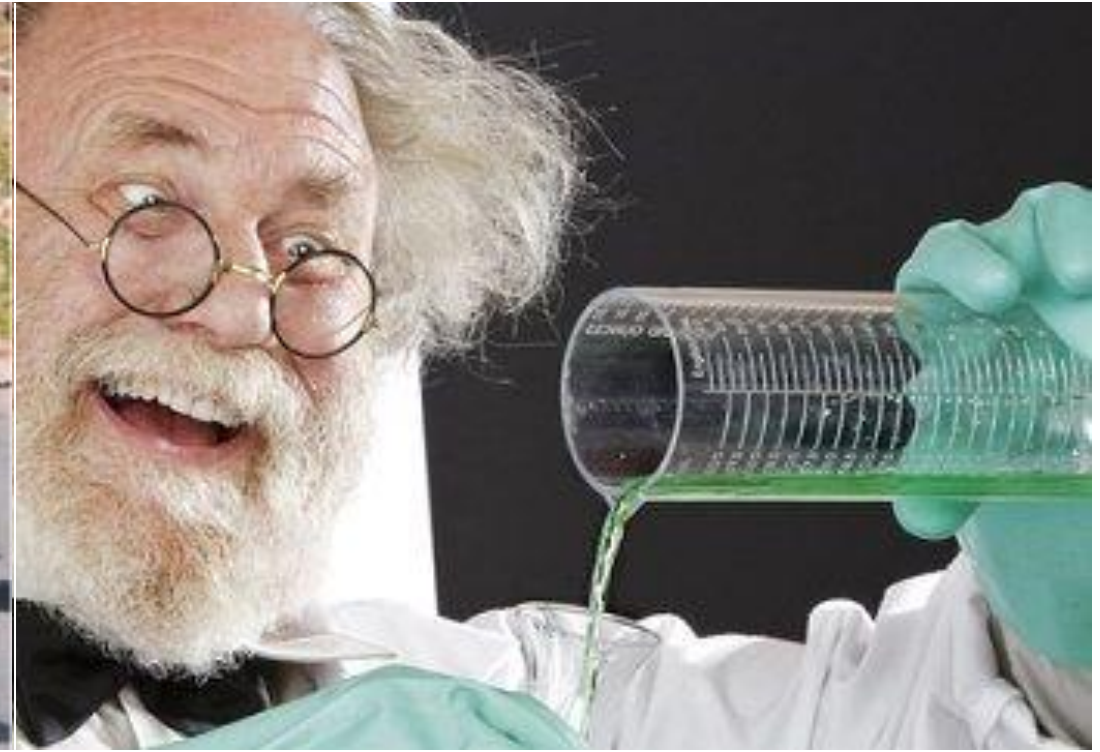
*"My sheep
